



HURRICANE IRMA AFTERMATH UPDATE # 5
(SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 17 @ 12:30 PM)

There are a total of 800 lift stations and 500 (62.5%) are on FPL power and the remaining 300 (37.5%) are running on generators and pumping stations. Collier County Public Utilities has stated that the water service continued yesterday and today, there was no need to shut the water down in the last 32 hours.

Please still continue to conserve water. Sampling of the water is ongoing and the preliminary results of the water are positive as of yesterday, but please continue to boil water for drinking and cooking.

Early figures state that 39% of Collier County residents still do not have electricity. We will get more figures later.
